RESOLUTION SUNFLOWER BASIN

Delta Council acknowledges the exposure of property and public services in the Sunflower Basin to flooding. During February and May of 1991, 470,000 acres in the Steele Bayou Basin and 700,000 acres in the Big Sunflower-Bogue Basin experienced extensive flooding for long durations, including residences in Bolivar, Humphreys Sharkey, Sunflower, Washington and Yazoo Counties.

Delta Council applauds the progress and success registered toward completion of the channel enlargement project which extends flood protection to Greenville and the watersheds of Bolivar and Washington Counties included in the Upper Steele Bayou project area. We also request that channel maintenance be performed to reduce flooding on the lower reaches of the Bogue Phalia-Big Sunflower River.
