Resolution Yazoo Basin Hydrology and Interagency Coordination

Delta Council recommends that the appropriate committee(s) of the organization establish and maintain an interagency forum whereby information is shared about planned and ongoing projects, surveys, studies, and evaluations pertaining to the soil and water resources of the Delta. Open forums for the exchange of information should be held periodically and on a sustaining basis throughout future years, in order to facilitate the overall objective of priority-setting and planning for resource agencies and the citizens of the Delta who share a common interest in these resources.

Such a forum which would provide a mechanism for sharing information should be held at least annually in the future and include, but not necessarily be limited to representatives from the following agencies: the Yazoo-Mississippi Delta Joint Water Management District, the Yazoo-Mississippi Delta Levee Board, the Mississippi Levee Board, the Natural Resources Conservation Service, the Soil and Water Conservation Districts, the Division of Agriculture, Forestry and Veterinary Medicine at Mississippi State University, USDA-Agricultural Research Service, and the National Sedimentation Laboratory, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, the U.S. Geological Survey, the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality, the Mississippi Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks, the Engineer Research and Development Center, Delta Council and the Mississippi Farm Bureau Federation.
